

RULES

1. Absolutely nothing may be thrown or handed out to spectators along the parade route (candy, pins, pamphlets, etc.) Violators will be removed from the parade. Each entry shall exercise all precautions for the safety of others and shall be responsible for their own vehicle (s) and or floats. No more than two (2) car lengths (40') will be allowed between entries. Driver of entry must be available at all times to move in the event of an emergency or relocation.
2. Discharging of firearms containing live or blank ammunition is prohibited.
3. Direction issued by Parade Officials and/or Law Enforcement Officials shall be strictly observed.
4. Participants should be dropped off within walking distance to their line-up station. Vehicles will not be allowed into the parade line-up area to drop off participants.
5. In case of snow: The committee will decide on Saturday morning whether to proceed. You can call Ava at 719.240.5521.
6. With all due respect, all entries should show association with the military, either past or present. Entries are approved by the Greater Pueblo Chamber of Commerce. No commercial advertising allowed (parade sponsorships excluded.)
